

In late summer, 1972, California s redwood forests seem a safe and wondrous place. But some of Evergreen s population is growing pot up in the trees and others are bent on stealing it. Clifford, surprised, is arrested and so brutally cuffed he fears for his hands. He then learns that one of the sheriff's nephews has just been murdered, and Alvaro is the posse's quarry.
