Among other schemes which came before the Committee was one by which several writers would undertake short monographs, which, though to a large extent independent of each other in subject and authorship, might when taken together form a survey and picture of the past history of the College. This plan was adopted, and it was found that the subjects naturally grouped themselves into such as were general in character (Vol. I), and such as dealt with special periods of time (Vol. II). Thanks to the loyal support of those who were asked to be contributors, the projected subjects were all soon taken up, and the first volume is now issued with its full complement of chapters and with more than its proportionate share of illustrations.
